- activation of immigrants within any activities implemented in favor of immigrant community,
- support for newly established organizations gathering or supporting foreigners in their self-development and implementation of their own initiatives.

Success factors

- it fosters integration of migrants into Polish communities
- a better command of the Polish language
- greater knowledge of the Polish law, including labour law; greater adaptability and resilience to the Polish labour market needs and expectations
- greater motivation to participate in voluntary services and providing peer-to-peer support within immigrant communities
- greater interest of NGOs or other organisations in help and support for immigrant communities
