

BEST PRACTICE POLISH LANGUAGE FOR A GOOD START (POLAND)



Short description

The project assumes linguistic and vocational education, development of socio-cultural and real-life competences conditioning the linguistic and non-linguistic activities of foreigners applying for international protection.

- Polish language course as a foreign language with elements of knowledge about Poland and vocational orientation (stationary classes, field lessons, mini educational projects, excursions and cultural outings),
- educational workshops on realism and soft skills (rights and obligations of foreigners in Poland, the basics of labor law, workshops on intercultural competences, lectures on knowledge about/ of Poland, good practices),
- development of methodological solutions for learning Polish as a foreign language for foreigners (curriculum at A1 / A2 level, test standards, textbooks for teaching Polish as a foreign language, taking into account communication situations specific to immigrants, Polish-Russian / Russian-Polish and Polish- English / English-Polish phrasebook).

Goals / objectives

Main goals:

- improvement of language skills (Polish language) of foreigners; acquainting them with the Polish culture and history; facilitating students self-directed learning/ successful independent study
- preparation of migrants for full participation in social, economic and civic life; knowledge of legal regulations; equipping migrants with skills enabling them to find a job
- helping migrants with finding and taking up the right job
- certification confirming the knowledge/ command of the Polish language by foreigners

Success factors

- it fosters integration of migrants into Polish communities
- more active participation of migrants in social, economic and civic life
- finding a suitable job relevant to an immigrant's skills and abilities
- a better command of the Polish language
- greater abilities and motivation of migrants to engage in the learning process and provide peer-to-peer support
